Im Gulielmi Elborne de Stapleford

In the Name of God Amen I William Elborne of Stapleford in the County of Leic. being in perfect health praised be God for the same but considering the frailty of man in his last state do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form following (viz.) First & principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator hoping through the merits of his Son & my Saviour Jesus Christ for pardon of all my sins My Body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named And as touching my worldly Estate which God of his infinite goodness hath blessed me withall I give & bequeath the same as followeth (that is to say) I give & bequeath unto my brother Thomas Elborne five pound of lawfull money to be paid him by my Executors within eighteen months next after my decease I give to my Nephews & Nieces, John Thomas, Robert Mary, Katherine, Elizabeth, Barbara, Margaret & Anne Sons & Daughters of my late brother John Elborne dead the sums of five pound a pece of like money to be paid them severally within twelve months next after my decease And if any of my said Nephews or Nieces shall happen to depart this life before their several Legacies shall become due & payable that then in such case this Legacy or Legacies of him her or them so departing this life shall be paid & divided unlore amongst his Survivors & Survivor of them in equal portions I give & bequeath unto my brother Robert Elborne the sums of five pound of like money to be paid him by my Executors within eighteen months next after my decease I give & bequeath unto my Nephews & Nieces Robert Thomas & Mary Elborne Children of my said bro. Robt. Elborne the sums of five pound a pece of like money to be severally paid them by my Executors within eighteen months next after my decease I give & bequeath unto my bro. Henry Elborne five pound of like money to be paid him by my Executors within eighteen months next after my decease I give & bequeath unto my Nephews Robert John & Thomas Elborne sons of my said bro. Henry Elborne the sums of five pound a pece of like money to be severally paid them by my Executors within two years next after my decease I give & bequeath unto my Niece Mary Elborne Daughter of my said bro. Henry Elborne the sums of ten pound to be paid her by my Executors

I give & bequeath unto my daughter
 the sum of twenty pounds of lawful money to be paid her by my executors
 after my decease or to her lawfull Guardian at her age of eighteen years or within two years
 after my decease which shall last happen. I give & devise all that my messuages
 or tenements wheresoever I now live in Stapleford aforesaid with the singular Houfes, Maltraps, Dishes,
 Buildings, Barns, Stables, Yards, Gardens, Orchards, & other appoyntments heretofore belonging
 together with four acres & an halfe of Land in Stapleford aforesaid. This with all up & unto
 my beloved wife Elizabeth Elborne for & during the term of her natural life And after her decease
 unto my Nephew William Elborne (son of my s^r bro^r John Elborne) & to his heirs and
 assigns for ever. I give & bequeath unto my s^r wife all the Household Goods &
 furniture of Household stuffs which was her own before & which she brought me at or came
 to my hands after our intermarriage together with all such arrears of Rent as now are due
 at my decease shall be due from any the Servants of or belonging to her own estate. Also I
 give to my s^r wife the sum of thirty pound of Lawfull money to be paid her within
 three Calendar months next after my decease. I give & devise all that messuages or
 tenements in Cusperford magna in the County of Essex which I lately purchased of Alice Diller
 widow with the appoyntments unto my Niece Katherine the wife of Thomas Cowland for and
 during the term of her natural life And after her decease unto her son William Cowland his heirs
 & assigns for ever. All the rest of my Real & personal estate whatsoever wheresoever and of
 what nature or kind soever (my debts Legacies & funeral Expenses being first paid & discharged)
 I give & devise unto my said Nephew William Elborne (son of my s^r bro^r John Elborne
 dead) & to his heirs & assigns for ever. And lastly (before my decease & making void all
 former Wills by me made) I do hereby nominate make & appoynt my s^r wife Elizabeth
 Nephew William Elborne joint Executors of this my last will & Testament contained in two
 sheets of paper. In witness whereof to this my last will & Testament I have subscribed in two
 sheets of paper I have set my hand & seal to each sheet the eighteenth day of
 October in the last year of the reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne by the grace of God
 Queen of Great Brittain et Anno dⁿⁱ 1713. Will. Elborne. Signed sealed each sheet of
 paper & the same published & declared by the s^r William Elborne the Executor (which word
 together with four acres & an halfe of Land in Stapleford aforesaid. This with all up & unto
 afterwards in the s^d Testament I have subscribed our Names as witnesses hereto unto
 In presence of the Reverend Tho. Hambleton of C^o Will. to be added annexed
 to this last will & Testament of me William Elborne of Stapleford in the County of Leint
 upon being in health of body & of sound mind memory & understanding as follows viz
 Whereas I have in & by my last will & Testament bearing date the eighteenth day
 of October Anno dⁿⁱ 1713. contained in two sheets of paper) nominated made & appoynted
 my loving wife Elizabeth Elborne & my Nephew William Elborne joint Executors of my
 last will & Testament. I do hereby revoke disannul & make void that part & Clause of my
 s^d last will & Testament. And my will & mind is & I do hereby make nominate constitute
 & appoynt my s^r dear & loving wife Elizabeth Elborne sole Executrix of my s^d last will
 & Testament. Ratifying & confirming the rest & residue & every part therof of my said
 last will & Testament. Making willing & declaring this present Codicillary part of the same.
 In witness whereof I the s^r William Elborne have hereto unto set my hand & seal
 this first day of June Anno dⁿⁱ 1714. Will. Elborne. Signed sealed published & declared
 by the s^r William Elborne as & for part of his last will & Testament in the presence of
 us who have subscribed our Names as witnesses hereto unto in the presence & at the
 request of the said Testator Ann Rogy Dir. Garrett Sam. Newby.
