But if the Estate is not sold to my Grandson the said Thomas Spencer Elborn & his Heirs &c then my will is that I do hereby dispose of my Mortgage, & all Right & Title to the above Estate at Trumpington, in the County of Cambridge, which I now occupy, & possess in manner & form following that is to say - First I give & bequeath to my Grandson Thomas Spencer Elborn, Twenty Pounds, Item I give to my Daughter Elizth Tookie Two Pounds & my Parlow Bed & Item I give to my Daughter Ann Elborn Five Pounds - Item I give to my Grand Daughter Sophia Elizth Elborn Five Pounds, Item I give to my Granddaughter Harriet Elborn Five Pounds. Item I give to my Son James Elborn my Clock & one Guinea for a Mourning Ring & likewise make him my Avidary Legatee Item to my Daughter in Law Elizth Elborn Five Pounds & one Guinea for a Mourning Ring Item to my Son in Law Francis Tookie one Guinea for a Mourning Ring, which is to show the love & friendship I have for all my children & Grand Children, & Lastly all my Furniture, Linen, Chineses wearing apparel, or any other real or personal Estate of any kind soever, that I am possessed of at the time of my decease I desire may be Equely divided betwixt my three Daughters Elizth Elborn, Elizth Tookie, & Ann Elborn, Share & Share alike, after payment of my Just Debts, & General Expences & I desire that all my Legacies may be paid within twelve Months & a day after my decease, & I do hereby constitute & appoint my Son James Elborn & my Son in Law Francis Tookie, Joint Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness hereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this 14th Day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty three W^m Elborn & Signed
